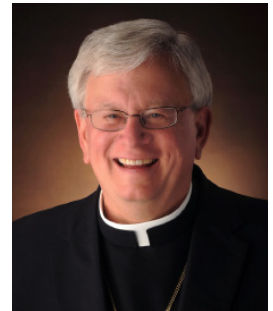

### THINKING OUTSIDE THE PILL: HUMANAE VITAE FOR THE NEXT GENERATION

St. Gianna Clinic and the Diocese of Green Bay are very excited to announce the 50th Anniversary Celebration of *Humanae Vitae*, Pope Paul VI's beautiful and clear encyclical on God's plan for married love and procreation.

The Most Reverend Bishop Ricken will join us and begin the evening by celebrating Mass, followed by hors d'oeuvres, dynamic speaker Dr. Teresa Stanton Collett, **and a special guest appearance by Dr. Gianna Emanuela Molla**, who is the daughter of St. Gianna Beretta Molla.

**Dr. Teresa Stanton Collett** is a national expert who will speak on "Thinking Outside the Pill." A professor at the University of St. Thomas School of Law, she specializes in the subjects of marriage, religion, and bioethics in her research.

**St. Gianna Beretta Molla**, an Italian pediatrician, wife and mother of four, suffered health setbacks during pregnancy, making her fourth labor and delivery a foreseeable high risk. Choosing her daughter's life over her own, she delivered Gianna Emanuela Molla in April 1962 and died one week later.
