

**Nominations for Parish Treasurer Trustee**

Wisconsin state law requires that the trustee be elected by members of the congregation. The term of office is two years and is limited to three successive terms with the possibility of reelection following one year of absence from office.

A parish trustee is an active, responsible parish member who is called to serve the parish as advisor, overseer, and counselor. The treasurer trustee works with the pastor in the coordination and maintenance of financial recordkeeping, reviews annual parish budget and signs the annual financial report to the diocese. The treasurer trustee holds an important role in the parish community as a member of the finance council and also has check-signing responsibilities.

**Criteria for Council Representative and Trustees:**

Must be 21 or older, A registered Parish Member, Confirmed practicing Catholic,  
Not a spouse of or parish staff

**Nomination Deadline:** March 24, 2019

**Election:** May 4 & 5, 2019
